All applications are reviewed by the Undergraduate Recruiting, Admissions and Student Affairs Committee. Consideration is only intended for students who have experienced extenuating circumstances, which affect or have affected academic performance.

As students will not have the opportunity to appear in person before the Committee, it is imperative that requests clearly outline the extenuating circumstances documented.

Please include a comprehensive letter (2-page max, typed) answering the following questions:

- 1) Contact Information: Full Name | Student Number | McMaster Email Address | Telephone
- 2) What specific relief are you seeking from this Committee?
- 3) What are the extenuating circumstances that were interfering with your performance?
- 4) When did you first notify the SE-Academic Office of your situation (who did you speak to)?
- 5) What advice were you given?
- 6) Has the situation been resolved? If so, how? If not, why not?
- 7) List of attached supporting documentation. It is highly recommended that you provide documentation to substantiate your case. This documentation should explain the duration, severity and impact of the situation as it relates directly to your academic performance. It should come from a party with first-hand knowledge of the situation.
